Key Stage 2 SATs information 2026

As we approach the Key Stage 2 SATs, here are some details to explain what will be happening during the week. The timetable for Key Stage 2 SATs is predetermined by the Government, so all KS2 children across the country are doing the same test on the same day. The timings are up to individual schools. All of our tests are scheduled to take place in the morning, and the dates of each test are as follows:

Date	Test
Monday 11 th May 2026	English grammar, punctuation and spelling paper 1: questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling paper 2: spellings
Tuesday 12 th May 2026	English Reading test
Wednesday 13 th May 2026	Maths paper 1: arithmetic Maths paper 2: reasoning
Thursday 14 th May 2026	Maths paper 3: reasoning

On the Monday to Thursday of SATs week (11th -14th May), we will be holding a free Breakfast Club, which will be open to all children in Year 6, starting at 8.15am in the school hall. This will include toast with different toppings, a variety of fruit and a drink – a great way to start the day! On Friday, the children should come in at the normal time and we will be serving some sweet treats at the start of the school day, as a way of celebrating the completion of the assessments and a reward for their hard work. Please let the School Office know if your child has any allergies that we need to be aware of.

Finally, in the lead up to SATs, it is important for all children to remain stress-free. We have seen just how hard all the children have worked in school, in preparation for these tests, and we are certain that every child will try their very best, with their results reflecting the effort they have put in. We encourage your child to practise some relaxation, such as meditation or mindfulness colouring, read a book, go for a walk and get some fresh air.
