1.	Timetabled curriculum music of at least one hour each week of the school year for key stages 1-3.	-All staff to follow Kapow curriculum lessons for 40 minutes per week -20 minutes per week to be dedicated to a Worship Through Song singing assembly which is planned and assessed	
2.	Access to lessons across a range of instruments, and voice.	-Children to have access to guitar lessons from an outside provider. - Year 4 children to have access to Ukulele lessons	
3.	A school choir and/or vocal ensemble.	-A school choir to be developed and maintained for children across both Key Stages	
4.	A school ensemble/band/group	School Choir to develop into a performance group	
5.	Space for rehearsals and individual practice.	Guitar lessons provided by an outside tutor to be held in school time and after
