

Outcomes:

By the end of this unit all pupils should know:

- The word God is a name.
- Christians believe God is the creator of the universe.
- Christians believe God made our wonderful world and so we should look after it.
- To know that Christians believe God created the world.
- To know that Christians believe that God is the giver of life and created our world.
- To know that Christians perform acts of worship to praise God for making the world
- To know that God created humans to be different
- To know that our planet is precious and we need to take care of it.
- To know that God is special to Christians

Progression:

Prior Learning: No previous learning via RE, though pupils may have heard about the Christian faith from home or Nursery Experience

Building Towards: YEAR 2

- God created the universe.
- The Earth and everything in it are important to God.
- God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator and Sustainer.
- Humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.

- Retell the story of creation from Genesis 1:1–2.3 simply.
- Recognise that 'Creation' is the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible.
- Say what the story tells Christians about God, Creation and the world.
- Give at least one example of what Christians do to say thank you to God for the Creation.
- Think, talk and ask questions about living in an amazing world.
