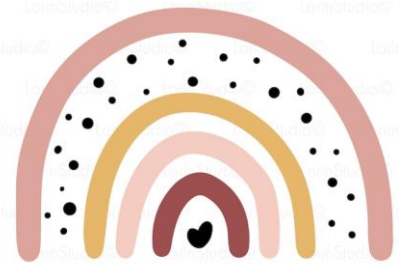



# Meet your SENCO

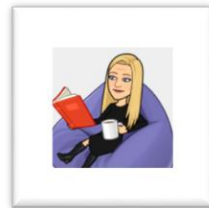
