During the half term, we will be thinking and learning about ourselves. We will be learning about Me and my Family, Me and my World and Me and my Body. We will be exploring what we look like and the idea that everyone is different and unique.

We will be learning about our local community and talking about our school.

We will be learning about our bodies, what they do and how we can look after them.

We will also be completing the statutory government baseline assessment.

Sticky Knowledge about...

- Children will learn the school rules and routines and get to know each other.
- All children and people are different and our differences are what make us special.
- Our family is unique, children will talk about their family and people who are special to them. A self- portrait is a picture that we can do of ourselves.
- Our body is made of a skeleton which keep us upright and our muscles help us move our body.
- Our skeleton is made up of different bones such as: a skull, spine (back bone), hip bone (pelvis), leg bone etc.



WOW Words (Subject Specific Vocabulary):

Rules and routines- These ensure that we are all kept happy and safe

Self – Portrait - A picture that we do of ourselves

Unique - We are all different and one of a kind.

Family - People you live with and care for you.

Family tree - A diagram that shows all of your family.

Skeleton - skeletons keep us upright.

Body parts - Hip, neck, shoulder, shin, leg, ankle, arm, elbow etc.

Muscles - Our muscles allow us to move.

Bones - Bones make up our skeleton, such as: a skull, spine (back bone), hip bone (pelvis), leg bone etc.

Senses - Ears are for hearing, Eyes are for seeing, our skin (hands) is for touching, our nose is for smelling and our tongue is for tasting.

Friendship - Being kind and having fun with others.

Feelings and emotions - Happy, excited, frightened, angry, sad, upset, shy etc.

Different, unique, colours and describing words to talk about hair, eyes and skin. House, bungalow, flat, townhouse, caravan, barn, Bridgwater, community. World, Somerset, town, country, street.

Body, heart, muscles, healthy eating, exercise, senses.

READING BOOKS - We will shortly be sending home a reading book for you and your child to share. Your child will have a reading diary which is used to list the books they read; we will change the books once a week (on a Friday). We will also send home information and tips on how to support your child with learning to read. If your child has read his/her reading book, please sign and date the reading record (Ideally four times a week). Books should be placed in the container on a Thursday or Friday morning. New books will go home on a Friday afternoon.

PHONIC HOMEWORK

We will shortly be starting our phonics learning. During the lessons the children will learn 4 phonic sounds a week as well as learning some harder to read and spell words.

The children will also learn how to blend and segment words.

Each week the children will bring home the sounds that we have learnt at school and it is important that you support them with their learning.

Please bring their phonic folder to school every Monday.

Ways to support children at home:

- Find some autumn items to bring in (no nuts please) – leaves, conkers, visit some woods, get muddy and climb trees!
- Read stories and discuss new words talk about what they mean. Talk about the story/characters/setting.
- Play Simon Says to practice naming body parts.
- Look at photos of family members when they were babies and talk about them.
- Look at photos of your child as a baby and talk about what they were like – talk about how they have changed.
- Ask the children to hunt for certain objects at home but instead of saying the word sound it out e.g. c-a-t. The children then need to work out what you have said and go and get it.
- Go for a hunt for objects that start with a specific sound.
- Practice your letters and sounds which come home in your phonic folder. (More information to follow)
- Find the numbers 1-3 in the environment on your travels.
- Count, Count, Count!
- Play 'Fishy, Fishy fingers'.


Questions:

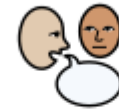

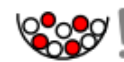

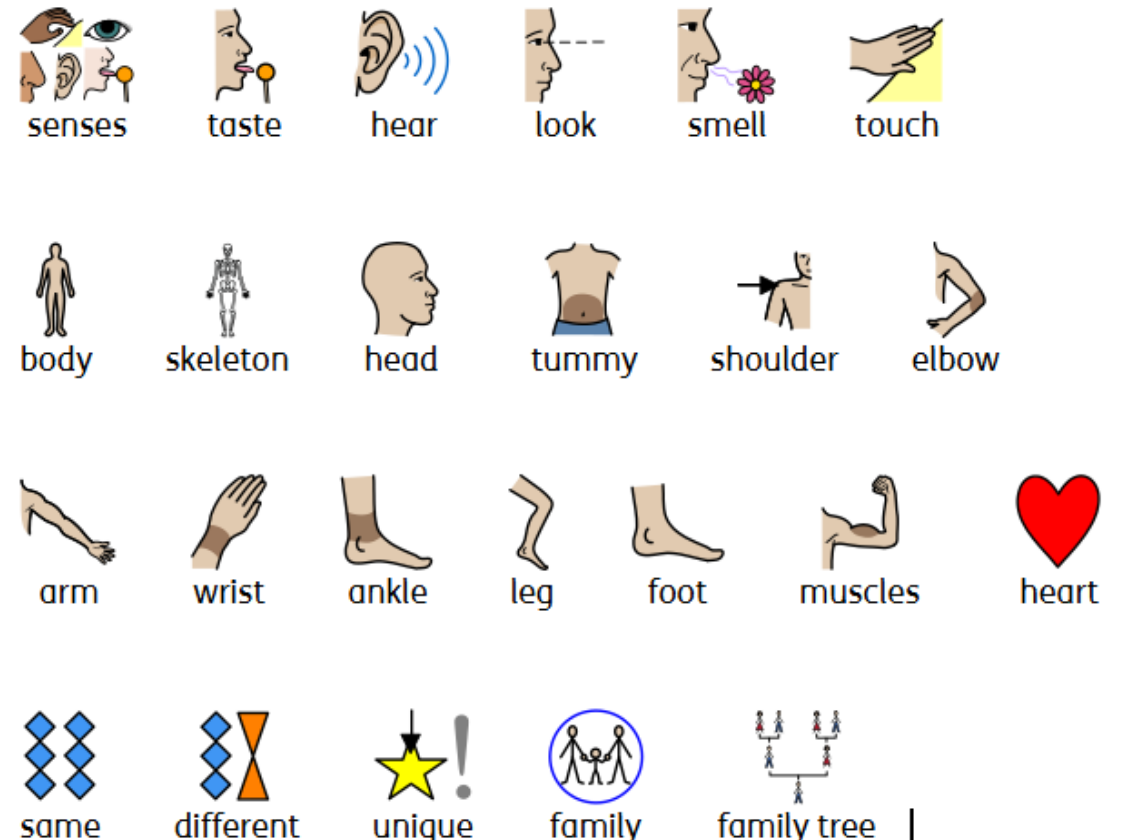
Understanding the World

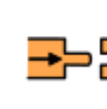

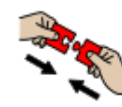

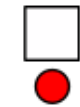

Self Regulation: My Feelings

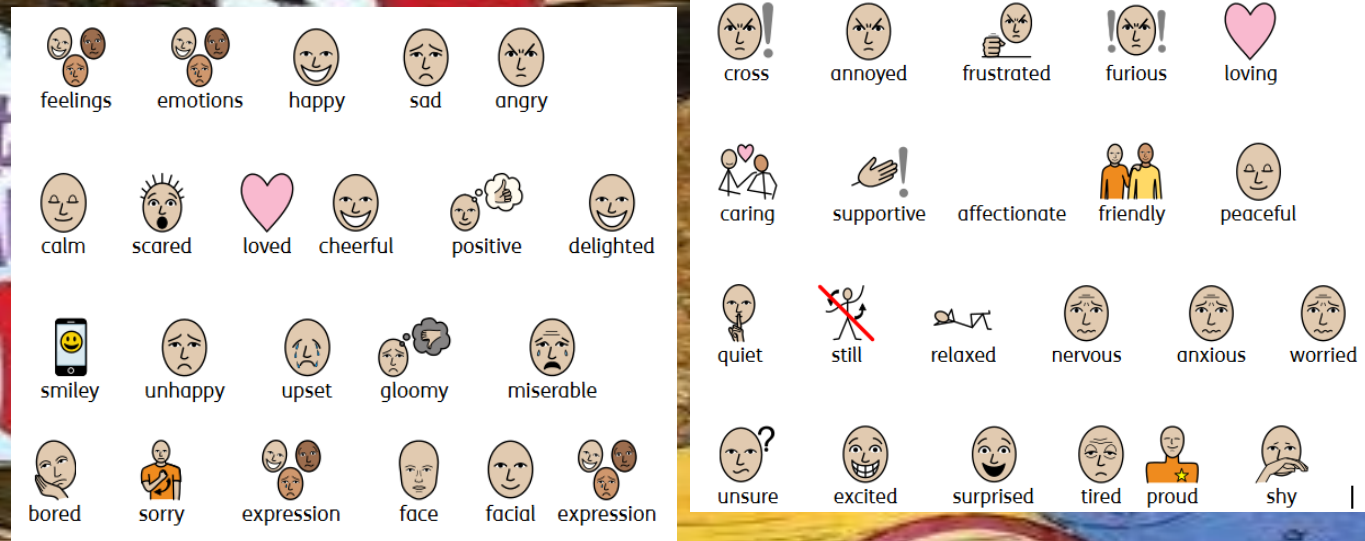
In this unit, children are learning to explore and understand their feelings, identify when they may be feeling something, and begin learning how to communicate and cope with their feelings and emotions.



What will I learn?

- To identify different feelings and emotions.

- To consider the reasons behind our emotions.
- To explore the different adjectives that can be used to describe feelings.

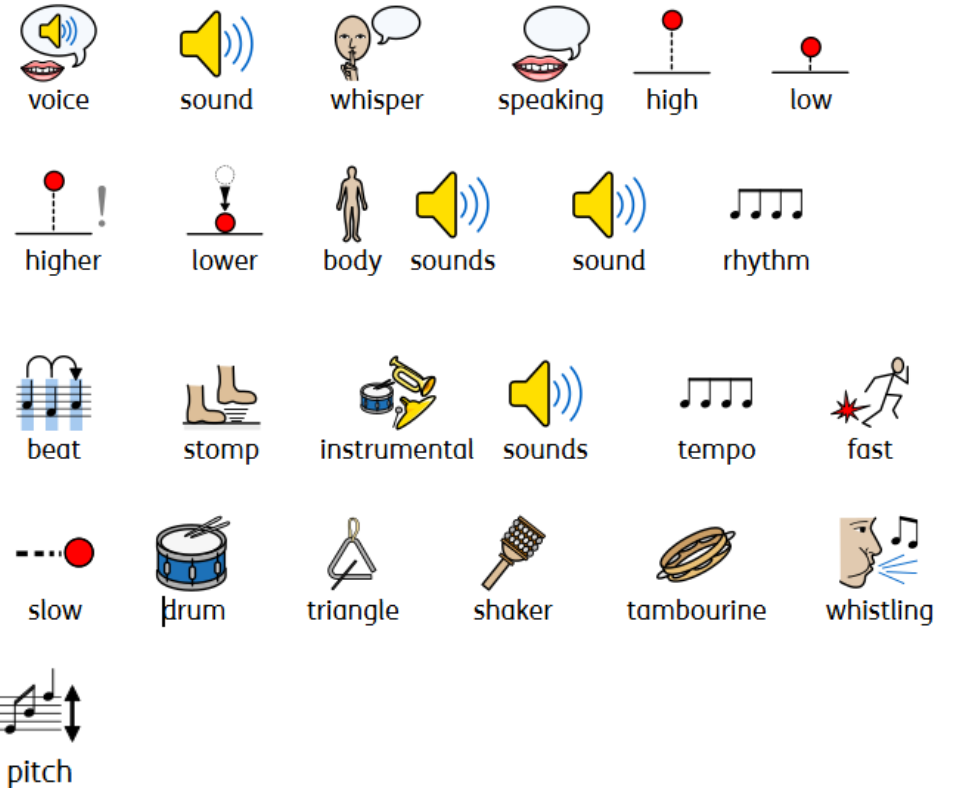
