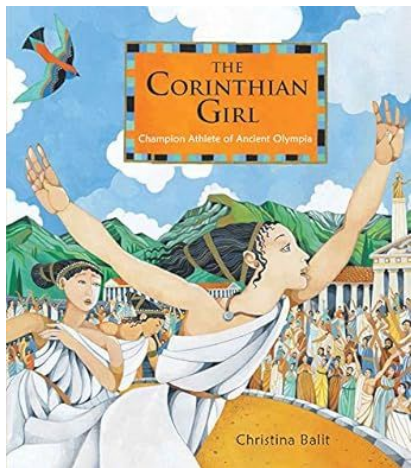

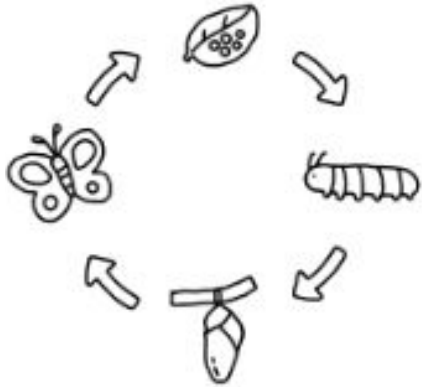
Animals, Including Humans

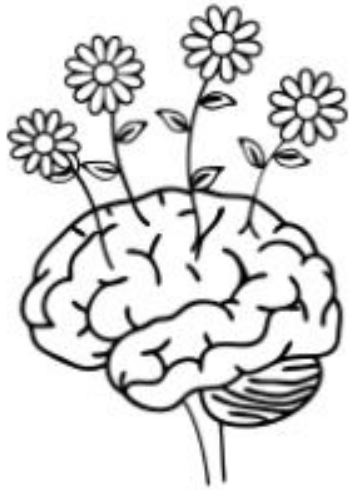

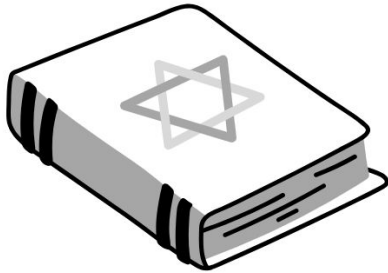

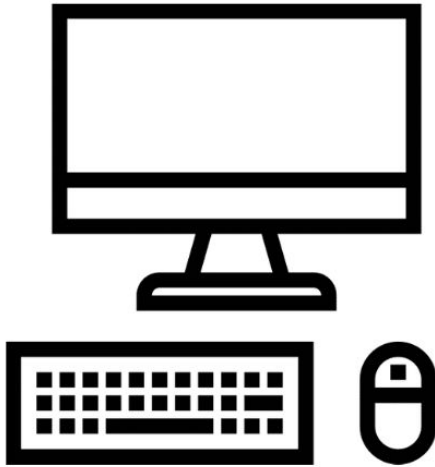
