## RE: Year 1 visit to Bristol Zoo Project - 24<sup>th</sup> March 2026

### About our trip

As part of our curriculum offering at St Mary's, Classes 1 and 2 will be visiting Bristol Zoo Project to support their scientific learning. The trip will include taking part in activities based around the zoo. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9:00am and returning at 3:00pm.

### Clothing

We ask that children wear their school uniform and bring a lightweight coat and sun hat. Please ensure that they are wearing sensible shoes. If it is sunny weather, please ensure sunscreen is applied before coming to school.

### Food and drink

You have the option to order a packed lunch on SchoolGrid or to send your child in with a packed lunch from home. Please ensure all lunches, and drinks are clearly labelled and in a named plastic bag (everything needs to be disposable).

### Cost

This trip will cost £18.00 per pupil. With the PFA contribution of £2.00 per term and the school contribution of £5.00 per term, for the trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£5.00** from parents/carers. Unfortunately, due to the rising costs of trips and the reduction in funding for schools, if we do not receive sufficient contributions then the trip will have to be cancelled. Contributions will need to be received by 20th March 2026 so that we can ensure that we have enough money to pay for it. If the trip is cancelled, then your contribution will be returned to you.
