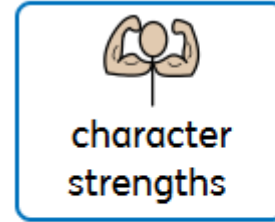
What will I learn?

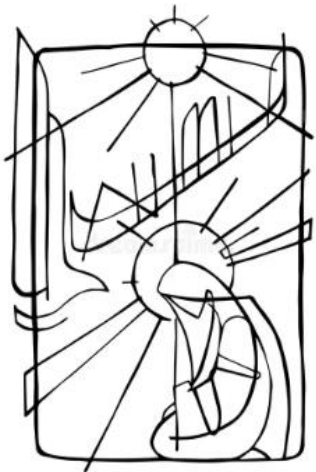

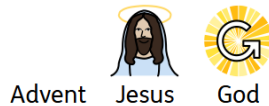
Christianity: Why does Christmas matter to Christians?

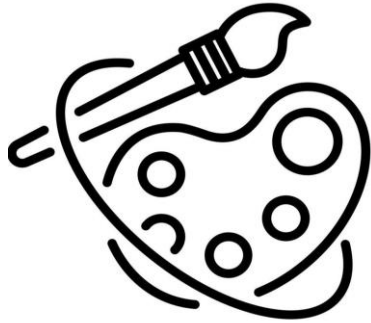

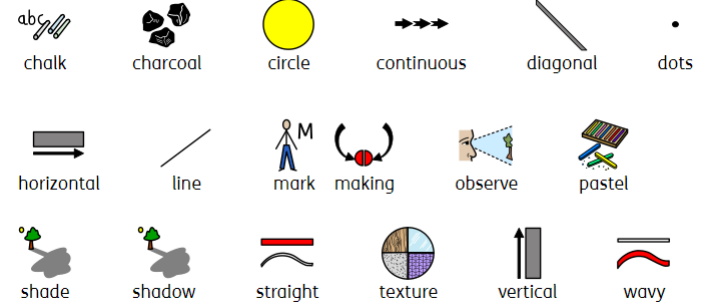
Drawing - Make Your Mark



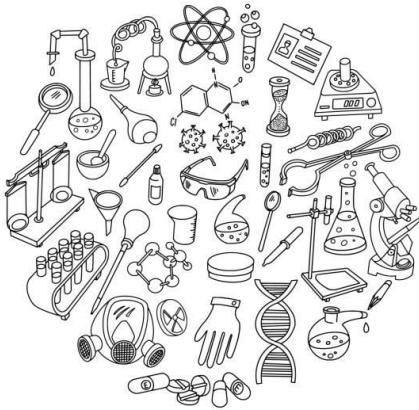
What will I learn?
